The Hawker Art Exhibition Committee is pleased to inform you that it will conduct its 27th consecutive annual Art Exhibition during September this year, and once again invites artists to submit works for display and sale.

We will again have a detailed presence on the Internet following the addition of this popular innovation in 1999. Please read the notice on the back of this letter which invites your participation. The upgraded website at www.hawkersa.info/haehome.htm enables you to download various documents

The exhibition will commence with an official opening on Friday 12 September. The exhibition will be open every day until 5pm on Friday 26 September.

We advise all artists who are intending to exhibit works in the Exhibition to carefully read the conditions of entry. Please complete all sections in full. If your method of return as stated by you on your entry form is to change for any reason, written notification must be received by the Secretary by 26 September. Entry Form and Packing Advice slips accompany this letter.

We advise that the best method of freighting paintings to Hawker is to use the Stateliner bus system. The bus system will still deliver to Hawker. The bus stops at Pt Augusta from which a contractor will deliver to Hawker.

Artists are advised that the Hawker Art Exhibition Committee is not registered for GST. Artist payment for sold works is the sales price less the usual commission. Therefore artists need to price their paintings to reflect their individual circumstances in relation to the GST.

Previous exhibitions have indicated that Australiana, rural landscapes, and in particular, Flinders Ranges scenes, tend to be most popular.

Please feel free to share the enclosed information with your artist friends who may also wish to enter the exhibition. Photocopied entry forms are acceptable.

We very much look forward to the participation of our many regular artists and those who may wish to enter for the first time.
