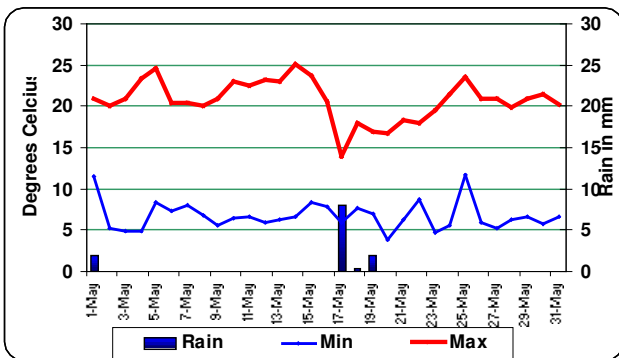

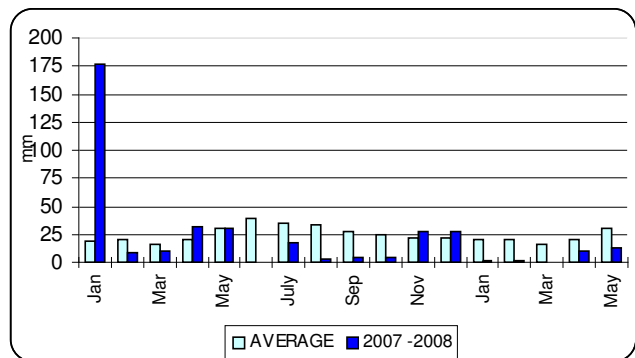

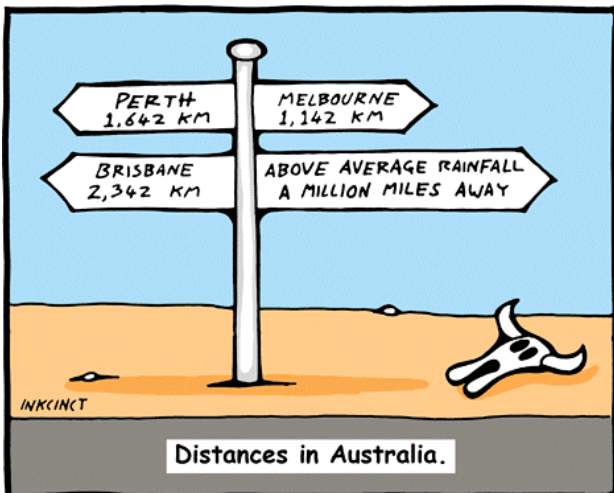
Hawker Temperatures May 2008



Hawker Rainfall 2007- 2008

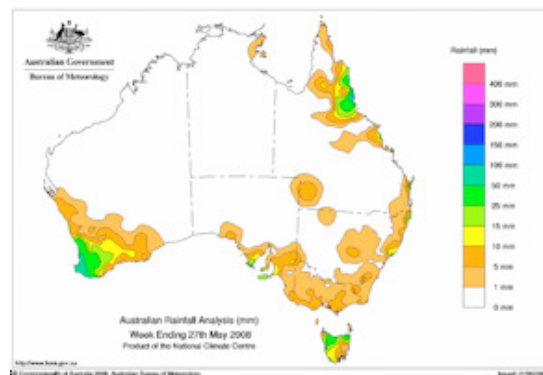
