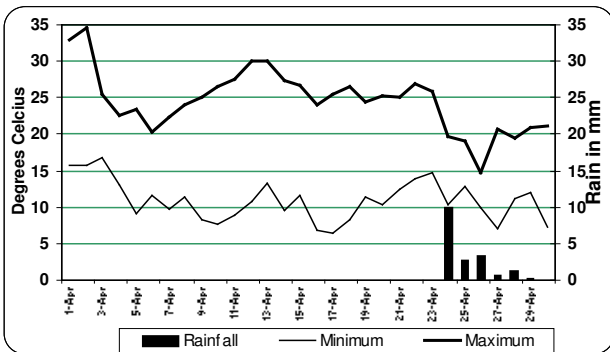


April 2009 Both day-time and night-time temperatures during April were very much within the temperate range expected during this autumn month. However, the only blip was the maximum of 14.7 recorded on 26 April. This has become the lowest recorded maximum for April, exceeding the previous low of 15.5 recorded on the 30th of April 1995. This coincided with the year's first real rain event when 18 mm was accumulated over six days.

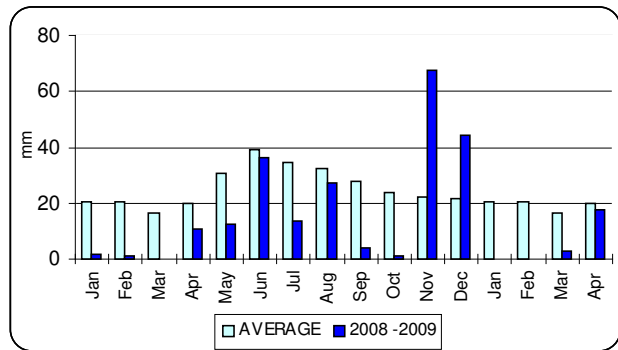

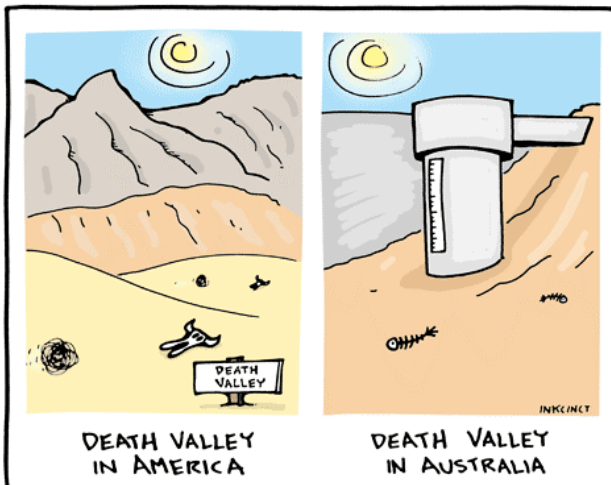
Hawker Temperatures April 2009
